Security Patrol Update- In light of recent events, we have decided that it would be beneficial to increase the security presence in the Village. As you may know, in the past we have shared our security patrol with the two other villages to provide monitoring of the community. Our Board has determined that despite an increase in expense, it would best for us to have our own dedicated patrol vehicle that would focus strictly on Woodsburgh and provide a more visible security patrol in our neighborhood. Additionally we suggest residents proactively safeguard property by locking your car doors, using your alarm and keeping your property well illuminated. .

As a reminder, if you plan to be out of town for the holidays or over the winter season, we suggest arranging to make sure your home appears occupied while you're away. You may also consider notifying Village Hall of the dates of your absence and we will be happy to complete a vacant premise form on your behalf. This form is recorded with the NCPD 4th Precinct and our own Village Security force and will assist in patrolling the neighborhood. This information is kept strictly confidential.
