With Hurricane season upon us, please take a moment to review the condition of the trees on your property. Arrangements should be made to remove any damaged or diseased trees as well as limbs and shrubbery that overhang the Village roadways, particularly at the corner intersections. This maintenance is the responsibility of each individual homeowner and your prompt attention is appreciated.

As school will soon be in session, a clear visibility triangle and ample standing area is critical for our children's safety while waiting for the bus. Please be sure to review corner intersections to make sure that shrubbery and tree growth is not impeding visibility to ensure the safety of all pedestrians and motorists alike.

Please note that garbage cannot be brought out to curb to be left for pickup. Garbage removal and recycling is done as a backyard pickup. We ask that you do not bring or leave garbage to the front of your home to be picked up. Any special pickup for removal should be directly addressed with the sanitation department and contact information can be found on the website under the important numbers and links tab.
