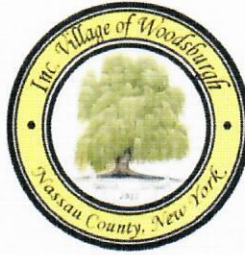

These are crimes of opportunity and even a momentary lapse is enough for an unfortunate event to occur. If you see something or suspect something please call 911 and let village hall know as well. Our LPR's are fully active and we are vigilant on our end to maintain the safety of the village, but need your help to do so. Please be sure to keep your house and property well it as well as doors and windows locked. Make a habit of using your alarm when both while away and at home. Notification forms of extended absences/vacation can be picked up at village hall and will alert the police and village security that you may be away for a period of time allowing them the insight to keep a special eye on your property.

Please note that the annual Village tax bill will be mailed at end of this month. Please feel free to call the Village office to confirm that the mailing information on record is current and correct. We appreciate your prompt attention to avoid any delays in remittance. In addition, please remind your gardener that permits must be renewed at Village Hall for the 2022 season. Only those gardeners holding valid permits will be permitted to work in the Village.
