All Governors are on one or more committees. There are three main committees, and two working groups.

- Committee A deals solely with Admissions.
- Committee B ("Business") deals with finance, personnel, property, health and safety.
- Committee C ("Children") deals with teaching, attainment, monitoring, and behaviour of children, plus the curriculum and links with the community.
- The Premises Working Group ensures the school property is a safe and positive environment for learning.
- The Community Working Group deals with community engagement

In addition governors have specific roles and responsibilities as noted below their names. Committees and roles are assigned by the FGB once per year in September.
