The Passion of Jesus - Readings for the 40 Days of Lent

DEFINITION OF LENT

Lent is a season of the Christian year that lasts for 40 days, beginning on Ash Wednesday and ending on Holy Saturday which is the day before Easter Sunday. During this time, Christians prepare for Easter by reflecting on their spiritual lives, repenting of their sins, and traditionally, performing acts of charity. This is a period of time to focus on Christ's sacrifice.

THE PURPOSE OF LENT

The purpose of Lent is to provide Christians with an opportunity to draw closer to God through prayer, and fasting. It is a time to reflect on one's own spiritual life and to seek forgiveness and reconciliation with God and others.

Fasting

- Self-discipline
- Breaking unhelpful habits
- Free up more time prayer
- Focus on forgiveness

Prayer

- Set aside a dedicated time
- Meditation or journaling
- Pray with others
- Use this prayer guide

Lent has also been a time of practicing increased acts of kindness and charity. The assumption is that as believers you are already doing this.

A time of prayer and self-denial in imitation of our Lord's sacrifices for us, leading to His joyful victory in resurrection!

Confession: I acknowledge my sinful heart and sinful ways.

Proverbs 28:13 - Whoever conceals his transgressions will not prosper, but he who confesses and forsakes them will obtain mercy.

My Praises to the Lord: Praise the Lord with Psalm 145

Psalm 145:1-3 I exalt you, my God the King; I will praise your name for ever and ever. Every day I will praise you and extol your name for ever and ever. Great is the LORD and most worthy of praise: his greatness no one can fathom.

I am Thankful: Recount His wonderful blessings.

Psalm 100:4-5 Enter His gates with thanksgiving, and his courts with praise! Give thanks to him; bless his name! For the LORD is good; HIs steadfast love endures forever, and his faithfulness to all generations.

My Prayer Requests: Ask Him for help, provision, guidance and wisdom.

Psalm 62:8 Trust in him at all times, O people; pour out your heart before him; God is a refuge for us.

This Week's Prayer Focus: Our Children and Grandchildren

- For fathers and mothers to stay committed to the Lord, His teaching and ways.
- For children to grow in faith and make a commitment to Christ.
- For the return to the Lord of our adult children who have moved away from the faith.
- For foster and adoptive ministries, children and families.

Psalm 78:3-4 things that we have heard and known, that our fathers have told us. We will not hide them from their children but tell to the coming generation the glorious deeds of the LORD, and his might, and the wonders that he has done.

Confession: I acknowledge my sinful heart and sinful ways.

Psalm 32:5 ~ Then I acknowledged my sin to You and did not conceal my iniquity. I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord," and You took away the guilt of my sin.

My Praises to the Lord: Praise the Lord with Psalm 103

Psalm 103:1-2 My soul, praise Yahweh, and all that is within me, praise His holy name. My soul, praise the Lord, and do not forget all His benefits.

I am Thankful: Recount His wonderful blessings.

Psalm 136:1-3 ~ Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good. His love is eternal. 2 Give thanks to the God of gods. His love is eternal. 3 Give thanks to the Lord of lords. His love is eternal.

My Prayer Requests: Ask Him for help, provision, guidance and wisdom.

Psalm 5:2 ~ Pay attention to the sound of my cry, my King and my God, for I pray to You.

This Week's Prayer Focus: Revival

- For a renewed devotion and passion for the Word of God.
- For a renewed devotion to prayer and an abiding relationship with Christ.
- For a renewed devotion for a loving and righteous lifestyle.
- For a renewed devotion to missions and sharing Christ's love to a dying world.

Romans 12:1-2 ~ Therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, I urge you to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God; this is your spiritual worship. 2 Do not be conformed to this age, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may discern what is the good, pleasing, and perfect will of God.

Psalm 107:8 ~ Let them give thanks to the Lord for His faithful love and His wonderful works for all humanity.

My Prayer Requests: I humbly ask for Him to touch ______ and I ask for His help, provision, guidance and wisdom.

Matthew 7:7 ~ "Keep asking, and it will be given to you. Keep searching, and you will find. Keep knocking, and the door will be opened to you.

This Week's Prayer Focus: Outreach

- For love for those who don't know Him.
- For new workers to the harvest fields and perseverance for those already there.
- For connections to the unreached in our own community.
- For boldness to proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Read Ephesians 6:10-18

- That we would remember our battle isn't against flesh and blood, but against the schemes of the evil one.

My Praises to the Lord: Praise the Lord with Revelation 1:1-8

Revelation 1:5 ~ "...from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood..."

I am Thankful: Recount His wonderful blessings, seen and unseen. Psalm 69:30 ~ I will praise God's name in song and glorify him with thanksgiving.

My Prayer Requests: I humbly ask for Him to touch ______ and I ask for His help, provision, guidance and wisdom.

Psalm 145:15-16 ~ The eyes of all look to you, and you give them their food at the proper time. You open your hand and satisfy the desires of every living thing.
