This week the lesson was entitled "The All-Encompassing Discipleship Jesus Desires." Our lesson focused on helping students understand that Jesus expects nothing less than all of us. He must take priority over relationships, comfort, our own desires, and everything that we have. Students were asked to consider surrendering any area to God that they have withheld from Him.

(This could lead to a great discussion about family priorities. Make sure to hear your teenager out and try not to get defensive if their impressions are hurtful and/or convicting.)
- What are some areas of your life where you have trouble giving God 100%? Are you willing to share with me some areas where you may be withholding from Him? Can I help you think of ways to make sure you are giving God priority in those areas?
- Jesus said that we cannot be His disciples if we are not willing to renounce all that we have for His sake. How do you feel about that?
