Hello! This week we looked at one of the most difficult commands for a believer, that we should be holy just as God is holy. This week, the lesson was entitled "Pursing Holiness." In it we read some of Peter's words to believers that were scattered abroad, encouraging them to be prepared for action. Students learned that Christ-followers should be set apart so that we look less like the world and more like Jesus.

As you get a chance this week, read this passage of Scripture and meditate on what Peter is calling all Christ-followers to be and to do.

## **NEXT STEPS...**

During the next week as you have time to talk with your teenager, remember that one way that will help him or her to understand and apply what he or she has learned is to explain it to someone else. Use the following questions to guide your conversation:

- How are you currently striving to be holy?
- 1 Peter 1:14 states, "As obedient children, do not be conformed to the passions of your former ignorance." Are there any passions you are struggling with? Consider sharing how God has moved in your own life to free you from previous sin.
- Pray with your child for his or her thoughts, words, and actions to become holy. Ask your child to also pray for you as you seek to be holy.
