

Day wise Itinerary

DAY 1 -: Pick Up from Bandaranaike International Airport and transfer to Galle

Galle is a city on the southwest coast of Sri Lanka. It's known for Galle Fort, the fortified old city founded by Portuguese colonists in the 16th century. Stone sea walls, expanded by the Dutch, encircle car-free streets with architecture reflecting Portuguese, Dutch and British rule.

- ✓ Visit Historic Galle Fort, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- ✓ National Maritime Museum and Dutch Reformed Church.
- ✓ Galle Lighthouse for panoramic views of the coastline and surrounding areas.
- ✓ Rumassala Sanctuary.
- ✓ Turtle Hatchery.
- ✓ Evening Relaxing at Unawatuna Beach.



DAY 2 -: Galle – Ella

Ella is a small town in the Badulla District of Uva Province, Sri Lanka governed by an Urban Council. It is approximately 200 kilometers east of Colombo and is situated at an elevation of 1,041 meters above sea level.

- ✓ Visit the Nine Arch Bridge in Ella. was built when Sri Lanka was under the British rule.
- ✓ Visit Tea Factory.
- ✓ Nildiya Pokuna.
- ✓ Little Adams Peak.
- ✓ Visit the Ella Ravana Cave Rock and Ravana Falls.



DAY 3 -: Ella – Dambulla

Dambulla is a city situated in the north of Matale District, in Sri Lanka's Central Province. It is the second largest populated and urbanized Centre after Matale.

- ✓ Visit Dambulla cave temple. It is the largest and best-preserved cave temple compound in Sri Lanka Golden Temple.
- ✓ Minneriya safari.

DAY 4 -: Dambulla

- ✓ Begin the journey with one of the wonders of the ancient world -the Sigiriya Rock Fortress. water garden, the boulder garden, The Terrace Garden, audience hall, Cobra Hood cave, Famous frescos, the mirror wall and graffiti, the terrace of lion staircase, the summit and you will also get to know some amazing fact and story about rock fortress then you will drive to. There are above 80 chronicle caves around this location.
- ✓ Pidurangala is a massive rock formation located a few kilometers north of Sigiriya in Sri Lanka. It has an interesting history closely related to that of the Sigiriya Rock Fortress.
- ✓ Village Tour Bullock cart ride, Catamaran Boat Ride, visit a Village House, activities and cooking demonstration at village house, taste a Herbal Drinks.



DAY 5 -: Dambulla – Kandy

Kandy is a large city in central Sri Lanka. It's set on a plateau surrounded by mountains, which are home to tea plantations and biodiverse rainforest.

- ✓ Visit Spice Garden.
- ✓ Visit world heritages as well as a sacred place for the Buddhists all over the world; namely the **Temple of tooth Relic** known to the Sri Lankans as Dalada Maligawa.
- ✓ Visit Kandy Lake, Kandy Viewpoint, Gem Museum.
- ✓ Kandy City tour, Visit Botanical Garden.
- ✓ Murugan Temple.

- ✓ Bahirawa Kanda Temple
- ✓ Traditional Kandyan dances include the cobra dance, mask dance and the Gini Sila (showing power over fire).
