Day 01

AIRPORT (KATUNAYAKE) / NEGOMBO

Pick up from Bandaranaike International Airport and proceed to Negombo and check in to Hotel. After lunch proceed to Chilaw.

Munneswaram Temple

Munneswaram Temple is an important Hindu temple complex in Sri Lanka. Located in Chilaw of Puttalam District, this temple complex has been in existence at least since 1000 C.E. The temple complex is a collection of five temples, which are popular among both Hindus and Buddhists. The central temple is the most prestigious temple within the complex, which is dedicated to Lord Shiva. The other temples are dedicated to Kali, Ganesha, and Aiyandar. The temple is one of the five ancient Pancha Ishwarams



Manawari Temple

At present this lingam at Manavari temple is named as Ramalingam as this lingam was erected by Rama. The epic of Ramayana depicts that Rama is an incarnation of Vishnu and a lingam is a representation of Shiva. Ramalingam is considered as an extraordinary object -of worship of -Hinduism. There are only two lingams in the whole world named after Lord – Rama while one is the Ramalingam at Manavari Temple and other one is in Rameswaram in India, the most sacred place in Tamil Nadu.

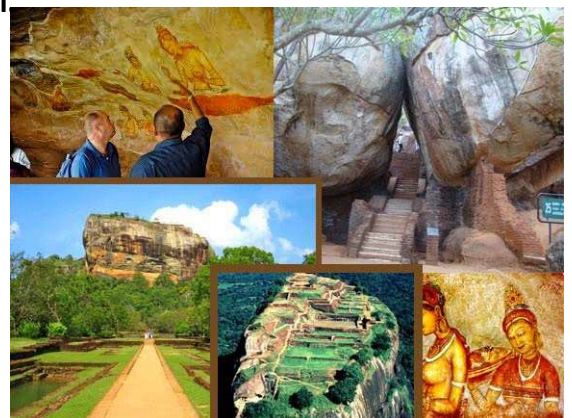
Day 02

SIGIRIYA

After breakfast proceed to Sigiriya and check in to hotel. After lunch visit the Sigiriya Rock Fortress.

Sigiriya Rock Fortress

This UNESCO World Heritage Site, a spectacular Rock Fortress, is one of Sri Lanka's major attractions. The most impressive facets of the unique complex are the Water Gardens, the Frescoes of beautiful maidens, the Mirror Wall with ancient graffiti, the Lion platform and the Summit of 1.6 hectares, which was completely covered by buildings during the period of Sigiriya's glory. Built by King Kashyapa (477-495 A.D), the "Lion Rock" is a citadel of unusual beauty rising 200m



from the scrub jungle. The rock was the innermost stronghold of the 70-hectare fortified town, and the base is ringed by a moat, rampart, and extensive gardens. The world-renowned frescoes (originally 500, of which only 19 remain today) which are in a sheltered pocket of the rock approached by a spiral stairway are

painted in earth pigments on plaster. The old stairway to the top led through the mouth of a crouching lion but today only the huge paws remain giving an indication of the massive proportions of the head. Remains of the handsome royal citadel are on the summit and several caves for meditation, audience platforms and baths complete the unique site.

Temple of Tooth relict

Temple of the Tooth Relic is a Buddhist temple in the city of Kandy, Sri Lanka. It is located in the royal palace complex of the former Kingdom of Kandy, which houses the Relic of the Tooth of the Buddha there. After witnessing the Cultural dance show in Kandy.

Day 04

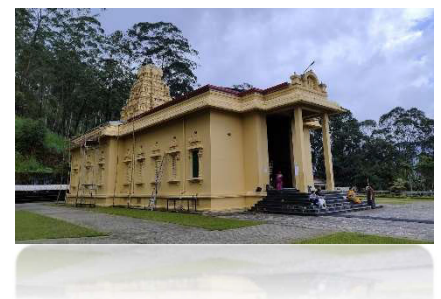
NUWARA ELIYA

Queen Sita, captured and brought to Sri Lanka, is said to have been hidden in this vicinity and the Hakgala Gardens is said to be one of the pleasure gardens of King Ravana called Ashok Vaoka.
