

Itinerary – Iceland 6-day Tour July 11 – 18, 2026

DAY 01: July 11, 2026

USA - REYKJAVIK

Depart the USA on your flight to Reykjavik, Iceland.

DAY 02: July 12, 2026

REKJAVIK (ARRIVAL)

(B)

Your private driver will meet you at Keflavik international Airport, and escort you to your coach. Your first stop is at the Viking World Museum café, where you will savor a Scandinavian breakfast. The remarkable design of the museum building lets you absorb the beauty of the Icelandic landscape or nearby harbor. After breakfast, travel to the famous Blue Lagoon, where you will experience a wonder of the world. As you harmonize with nature, you will emerge from the geothermal seawater feeling rejuvenated. Following this idyllic experience, you will travel to the capital city of Iceland, Reykjavik, and check in to your hotel. Rest of the evening is at your leisure.





DAY 03: July 13, 2026

REYKJAVIK

(B)

Enjoy a free morning, then be ready for a boat ride to watch the puffins. Get onboard Skúlaskeið or "Old Skuli", for a short ride to puffin island, Akurey, to see these cute birds and other colorful birdlife. Enjoy a view of Reykjavik from the ocean, as your guide share information about the buildings and islands that can be spotted along the way.







DAY 04: July 14, 2026

SOUTH SHORE

(B

After breakfast, you will visit the South Shore. You will view the picturesque waterfalls, Seljalandsfoss and Skógafoss. Take a walk along Reynisfjara black sand beach. Learn about life in Iceland from the settlement period to modern times, at the Skógar Folk Museum. Enjoy a walk through the charming village of Vík, before returning to Reykjavik.



After breakfast at your hotel, you will enjoy a full day tour of the Golden Circle. You will be impressed by Gullfoss, one of the most impressive waterfalls in Europe. At the Geysir Area, be sure to wait for Strokkur to spew its fountain of hot water more than 40 feet into the air. In Pingvellir National Park, you will discover the history of Iceland's ancient assembly and the two tectonic plates shaping the landscape around it. Visit the Fontana Geothermal Bakery to witness how bread is baked underground using geothermal heat. Finally, unwind in the warm geothermal waters of Laugarás Lagoon, where you will relax and enjoy the breathtaking scenery of the mountains and the Hvítá River. After your bath, you will return to Reykjavik.

DAY 06: July 16, 2026

REYKJAVIK

(B)

After breakfast you will embark on a city tour of Reykjavík. Admire the Sun Voyager, a striking steel sculpture, stop by the Harpa Concert Hall, and the Parliament of Iceland (Alþingi). Reykjavík City Hall, uniquely built on the edge of Tjörnin pond, and Hallgrímskirkja, a stunning church inspired by basalt lava flows, will let you experience some awe-inspiring sites. Perlan, a glass-domed landmark with a breathtaking viewing platform, showcases many wonders of Iceland. Experience a volcanic eruption at the Lava Show, before participating in a state-of-the-art technology that gives the feeling of flight. You will hang suspended, feet dangling, before a 20-metre spherical screen while a film whisks you away on an exhilarating journey across Iceland.



DAY 07: July 17, 2026

Sky Lagoon

On this final day in Iceland, you will have a free morning. In the afternoon, you will be transferred to the Sky Lagoon, a geothermal spa where visitors can soak in the warm waters while gazing out over the North Atlantic Ocean. Here you will experience the Skjól Ritual, before you return to your hotel and pack for departure.

DAY 08: July 18, 2026

REYKJAVIK – USA (DEPARTURE)

Your Reykjavik vacation ends today. You will be picked up for transfer to the airport.
