## What will your support help us to achieve?

#### To give you an idea how your support could help us:

## History maker's packages

#### Marsh P Johnson package - £500

The Marsha Johnson package includes:

- Your logo on our supporters board,
- Your logo on our website in the supporters section
- Invite to Pride in Luton launch and vigil on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> June
- A shout-out and thank you on our social media channels. This can include a link to your organisations work around LGBTQ+ support.

Marsha P Johnson was a gay liberation activist and an African-American transgender woman. Known as an outspoken advocate for gay rights, Marsha was one of the prominent figures in the Stonewall uprising in 1969. She co-founded the gay and transvestite advocacy organization S.T.A.R. (Street Transvestite Action Revolutionaries), alongside close friend Sylvia Rivera.

#### Gilbert Baker Package - £1000

The Gilbert Baker package includes everything in the Marsha plus:

- A shout out as a key supporter in our media and press releases.
- An opportunity to record a supporter's video that will be put on our social media, website.



Gilbert Baker was an American artist, gay rights activist and designer of the rainbow flag which debuted back in 1978. In 2017, Baker died in his sleep at the age of 65 in his New York City home.

#### Oscar Wilde Package - £3000

The Oscar Wilde packing includes everything from the Gilbert Baker package plus:

- A thought piece/ blog for the website on why it's important for your organisation to be supporting *Pride in Luton*.
- A mention on stage by the compere to thank your organisation as a key sponsor.
- Logo to appear on flyers and posters

Oscar Wilde was one of London's most popular playwrights in the early 1890s. He is best remembered for his epigrams and plays, his novel 'The Picture of Dorian Gray', and the circumstances of his criminal conviction for homosexuality and imprisonment at the height of his fame. In 2017, Wilde was pardoned for homosexual acts under the Policing and Crime Act 2017. The Act is known informally as the Alan Turing law.



#### April Ashley package - £5000

The April Ashley package includes everything in the previous packages plus:

- An offer for a member of the Pride in Luton committee to come and speak with your organisation about Pride in Luton.
- Quoted in the pride press releases as a supporter\*

April Ashley was a singer who was outed as Trans by the Sunday People in 1961. She campaigned for equal rights for Trans people since then and was awarded an MBE for her services to transgender equality in 2012.



- £2,000 support for the Arts and Crafts area (includes Gilbert Baker package)
- £3,000 support for the volunteer T-shirt on the Hosts and committee T-shirts (includes Gilbert Baker package)
