

wait list will be established when the program has reached capacity. New SCOPE parents must create an online account before registering a contract. PRE-REGISTRATION – MARCH 1 for current SCOPE child care students and a limited number of incoming Pre-K and Kindergarten students; April 1 for those waitlisted PRIOR TO JUNE 30 for the current school


