Notes for Completion of Application Form

- 1. Applications can be made only by a Solicitor holding a current Certificate to practice from the Law Society of Scotland.
- 2. Must include the name of the Barony, the Parish or Parishes and the Registration County in which it lies.
- 3. Details of a Crown Charter of Erection or a Crown Charter of Progress which includes the barony in question with recording or registration dates in a Public Register.
- 4. Name and address of person seeking to register the claim for the Entitlement.
- 5. Details of recorded/registered Title prior to 28 November 2004 on which the right of the person registering the claim is based.
- 6. Payment of the relevant fee must be sent to the bank account of the Scottish Barony Register, details available from the custodian.
