Notes for Completion of Application Form

1. Applications can be made only by a Solicitor holding a current Certificate to practice from the Law Society of Scotland.
2. Must include the name of the Barony, the Parish or Parishes and the Registration County in which it lies.
3. Details of a Crown Charter of Erection or a Crown Charter of Progress which includes the barony in question with recording or registration dates in a Public Register.
4. Name and address of person seeking to register the claim for the Entitlement.
5. Name and address of person assigning the claim to the Entitlement to the Dignity of the Barony to the Applicant.
6. Details of recorded/registered Title prior to 28 November 2004 on which the right of the person assigning the claim is based. This should be either a Title in the name of that person or someone from whom that person derives right by a series of links in Title.
7. Payment of the relevant fee must be sent to the Bank Account of the Scottish Barony Register, details available from the Custodian.
