## The categories and criteria for each category are as follows:

Category	Category Information	Criteria
The Community Champion Award	This Award recognizes individuals who demonstrate outstanding dedication in fostering positive change through volunteering and helping others. They lead or support local initiatives, and inspire others through their selfless contributions.  By honouring these exceptional individuals, the award highlights the impactful difference one person can make in creating a stronger, more connected community.  There are 3 categories:  Contribution to the Arts Contribution to Mental Health Contribution to Health and Fitness	This person must be over the age of 18 and be a resident of the Glossopdale area (for territory guidelines please see the Rules and Guidelines document found on the website or by contacting the GCC Admin Team) This can be a person who is employed to perform these tasks BUT must be someone who goes above and beyond in their duties. This must be detailed in full on the nomination form. This can also be a volunteer or unpaid person. This can also be a paid person who performs these tasks on an extra-curricular basis
The Green Hero Award	This Award recognizes individuals who have made exceptional contributions to environmental sustainability and ecological preservation.	This person must be over the age of 18 and be a resident of the Glossopdale area  This can be a person who is employed to perform these tasks BUT must be someone who goes above and beyond in their duties.

	This prestigious honour celebrates innovative solutions, impactful projects, and unwavering dedication to protecting our planet.  By highlighting these green champions, the award aims to inspire others to take meaningful action for a healthier, more sustainable future.	This must be detailed in full on the nomination form.  This can also be a volunteer or unpaid person. This can also be a paid person who performs these tasks on an extra curricular basis
The Outstanding Volunteer Award	This Award recognizes an individual whose exceptional commitment and passion have made a profound impact on our community.  Through unwavering dedication, innovative approaches, and a spirit of service, this volunteer has significantly advanced our mission and inspired others to contribute.  Their selfless efforts exemplify the highest standards of volunteerism and bring positive change to those we serve.	This person must be over the age of 18 and be a resident of the Glossopdale area  This can NOT be a person who is employed to perform these tasks and initiatives  This person can be nominated for this Award because of voluntary work for either one or more groups, charities or associations
Glossopdale Unsung Hero Award	This Award recognizes an individual whose exceptional contributions often go unnoticed but have a profound impact on their community or organization.	This person must be over the age of 18 and be a resident of the Glossopdale area

	This award honours those who selflessly dedicate their time and energy to making a difference behind the scenes.	This can NOT be a person who is employed to perform these tasks and initiatives  This person can be nominated for this Award because of voluntary work for either one or more groups, charities or associations
The Junior & Youth Community Champion Awards	These Awards recognizes extraordinary young individuals who have made significant contributions to their communities or inspired others through their actions.  By celebrating these young heroes, we aim to highlight their impact and encourage future generations to strive for excellence and compassion and support local charities.  There are 3 categories in this section:  Junior Community Champion – Open to those aged 12 or under Youth Community Champion – Open to those aged 13 to 18  Young Adult Community Champion – Open to those aged 18 - 25	This person must be within the age bracket for their category at the date of the Awards (Thursday 24 <sup>th</sup> April 2025)  They must be a resident of the Glossopdale area  This person can be nominated because of one or more events or situations, or because of their work towards a project or multiple projects be that short or long term  For the under 18 categories -  This person can be nominated by anyone but the nominator must gain parent or carer approval before nominating  Contact details on the nomination form must be that of the nominees parent or carer/

The Community Champion Group of the Year	This Award honours a group that has demonstrated exceptional dedication to fostering positive change and building strong, inclusive communities.  This group has made significant contributions through innovative programs, collaborative efforts, or impactful outreach, creating lasting benefits for its members and the wider community.	The nominations for this award must be for a voluntary group or charity group.  Businesses cannot be nominated unless their efforts being nominated are separate to their main business purposes  Groups can be nominated by their members/volunteers
	Their commitment to service and excellence embodies the spirit of community and inspires others to engage and contribute.	
The Community Champion of the Year Award	This Award celebrates an individual who shows remarkable dedication to their community.	This person must be over the age of 18 and be a resident of the Glossopdale area
	This accolade acknowledges a person who has gone above and beyond to add significant value to their Community.	This can be a person who is employed to perform these tasks BUT must be someone who goes above and beyond in their duties.  This must be detailed in full on the nomination form.
	They demonstrate exceptional leadership and a sincere commitment to enhancing the lives of others.  Through their selfless actions, the recipient has	This can also be a volunteer or unpaid person. This can also be a paid person who performs these tasks on an extra curricular basis

The Lifetime Commitment to Community Achievement Award	This Award honours an individual who has demonstrated sustained dedication and exceptional service to the betterment of their community.  This award recognizes a lifetime of meaningful contributions that have significantly improved the quality of life for others, fostering growth, unity, and positive change.  It celebrates not only individual accomplishments but also the impact on the collective well-being of the community.	This person must be over the age of 18 and be a resident of the Glossopdale area  This can be a person who is employed to perform these tasks BUT must be someone who goes above and beyond in their duties. This must be detailed in full on the nomination form.  This can also be a volunteer or unpaid person. This can also be a paid person who performs these tasks on an extra curricular basis  This person must have performed these tasks and initiatives for a significant proportion of their life within the Community – please provide as much detail as possible about this on the nomination form
