

# Case Study: Milton Keynes

Type: Hydroseeding Urban Green corridors



Milton Keynes Council had been suffering from several illegal caravan sites being set up on the green corridors throughout the town and have constructed bunds of varying sizes to prevent access onto the land.

As these were constructed using subsoils as opposed to topsoil, the amount of larger debris precluded the use of conventional cultivation and seeding equipment.

Therefore, to maintain the appearance of these green corridors, several hectares were hydroseeded by CDTS Ltd with Perennial Wildflower seed mixtures.

This was the perfect site to mobilise our smaller 2500 litre towed hydroseeding units which enabled us to pull safely off the live highway onto soft verges, into laybys and utilise the wider footpaths where necessary to access the bunds safe and efficiently.
