Equipment Maintenance: Not too much to report Had to have Alta Equipment in for the excavator one of the sensors in the emissions system failed. Other than that just a couple of fittings on 118 sander fail, a couple of lights need to be rewired and a seal was leaking on a spinner motor on 115.

Road Maintenance: The guys have been keeping busy taking dead ash trees down threw out the town I think we've added another 10 trees to the list. We had a tree come down Sunday night in the wind storm on Nash road took down three poles so were working with NYSEG to take 5 additional dead ash trees on Nash road that could potentially take the wires and poles down again. The guys have gone out and installed snow fence on Hamilton, Jordan Rd and Kester Rd hopefully it helps with wind spots.

Winter Readiness: order another 400 ton of salt that puts us up to 1000 tons this year so far.

Buildings/Grounds I've contacted some builders for prices on pole barns I will be meeting with them at the beginning of the year about a barn to house equipment so in the winter we can store the JET vehicles. With them being outside and having to brush them of is creating a safety issue one driver has already fallen on ice more discussion to come after I get some prices.
