Town of Elbridge Senior/Recreation Report

May, 2025

RECREATION:

General Information: The NCLL baseball/softball plans are complete for spring 2025. Registration is over. The final count – shows JE Little League is pushed nearly to the 200 youth player mark. Excellent numbers! We also have been able to secure sponsorship for all the teams. This is the first time in a very long time that every team will have a different sponsor. Community support for the recreation program is incredible. The JE grounds crew has agreed to support the maintenance of the playing fields for another year. Their support and expertise is invaluable. The game season has begun. Even though the weather has been somewhat uncooperative, we are getting games in.

We are excited to announce hosting our first complete Summer Musical Camp. The dates of the camp are July 14-26. The students will be performing SHREK JR. We are very fortunate to have JE music teachers: McKayla Comstock and Andrea Love along with Joanna Kuffs as our lead instructors. Registration has begun and we are over 60 kids at this point. We are hoping to have 100 students involved.

We have teamed with Challenge Island for two-week long summer camps. The camp will be at the community center on July 28-Aug 1 themed Islandmon Steam Quest and Aug.11-15 entitled Steam-Warts, camp of wizards, spells and potions.

The youth lacrosse Sunday clinic ended. We had 40 players come to the free session. We will have to more Sunday sessions as summer comes. We are actively recruiting players to create teams and join a couple of local community based tournaments. We are hoping for multiple aged boys and girl's teams. At this time, we should have a girls K-2 team and grade 3/4 team for the King of the Hill Tournament (JD) and the Valley (Syracuse) Tournament. It is a good start for the program.

JE SENIORS:

General Information: The 2025 senior program schedule is well underway. We have had good attendance at our weekly lunches. Our first trip is May 7 to Elmira and the surrounding area. People are excited to start traveling. We will have a small group for this trip. That is good as it gives more time for personal exploration.

Our next scheduled trip will be on June 11 for the Lockport Tours and Canal Experience. We have 48 people registered and we can take up to 50. I anticipate this being sold out.

May is Senior Citizen Recognition Month and on May 20 we will have a specially prepared PEACE lunch and entertainment by local musician Dale Randall.

LeMoyne College has again selected the JE Senior Program as a site for a free 7 week Fall Prevention Program. This will include education on fall risk factors and simple exercise ideas. We are hoping to have participation around 15-20 of our senior community members.

Painting class is also very active. 10-15 people participate on Tuesday and Fridays.

The senior work out program is going well. We are continuing to recruit.

JET:

The JET program is running full force. While we are always recruiting drivers, we have nine active drivers at this time. We were able to add several new drivers recently. A few other drivers have relocated to warmer climates for the winter. When they return from their winter travels, all are looking to drive again for us. We had our annual County assessment meeting and did fine.

COMMUNITY CENTER RENTALS:

Rentals are strong in 2025. We will schedule double parties in Lion's Den and Community Room for 2025. Already, most weekends are getting booked
