## **RECREATION:**

**General Information:** The NCLL baseball/softball plans for spring 2025 are underway. Registration forms have been released and open to the public to register. Most of the registrations will be handled via an online registration format. This is similar to last year's program. It is an excellent format for people to register.

The CCYO basketball league is winding down. We had over 180 kids registered to play. This is a higher number than in past years. We were thankfully able to find coaches for all the teams. Practices and games seem to be going well. It is a busy time! The instructional Saturday morning session with the JE Varsity players and coaches is complete. 30 kids registered and we had upwards of 50 show when the weather cooperated. The varsity coaches and players ran the 5-week session as a fund raiser for their respective programs.

The school February break is coming up and we are planning a youth basketball camp. This will be a three day (half day) format. The varsity coaches and players will be working the camp.

We are excited to announce hosting our first complete Summer Musical Camp. The dates of the camp are July 14-26. The students will be performing SHREK JR. We are very fortunate to have JE music teachers: McKayla Comstock and Andrea Love along with Joanna Kuffs as our lead instructors. A budget and program plan is being prepared. All practices and performances will be held at the JE HS.

## **JE SENIORS:**

**General Information:** The 2025 senior program schedule is complete. We are working on the finalizing the 2025 trip plans. This should be completed in the next week or two.

LeMoyne College has again selected the JE Senior Program as a site for a free 7 week Fall Prevention Program. This will include education on fall risk factors and simple exercise ideas. We are hoping to have participation around 15-20 of our senior community members.

The Upstate University Hospital mobile mammography van will be on site February 18 for free breast cancer screenings.

Painting class is also very active. 10-15 people participate on Tuesday and Fridays.

The senior work out program is going well. We are continuing to recruit.

**JET:**

The JET program is running full force. While we are always recruiting drivers, we have nine active drivers at this time. We were able to add several new drivers recently. A few other drivers have relocated to warmer climates for the winter. When they return from their winter travels, all are looking to drive again for us. We had our annual County assessment meeting and did fine.
