

Turn on the clock using the ON button on the front lower left corner of the clock. Once on, make sure the sound is off. If the image of a note is on the front panel, toggle the associated button in the upper right corner of the center set of buttons.

Once on both times displayed will start blinking.

The center area is where you can set a delay or increment.

To start this process hit the right arrow at the 3:00 position on the dial.

Use the '+' to toggle between different modes which include 'Game TImer + delay' and 'Game Timer + bonus'

Once you pick the one you want, you can 'select' it with the right arrow at the 3:00 position on the dial.

If your time control is a delay, select it and then use the '+' and '-' keys to select the tournament delay setting.

If you want to do 'Game
Time + Bonus' you can
reset the timer (toggle
the on button for less
than 2 seconds) and
follow the same
procedure.

This same method is used to set the actual game time. Toggle using the '+' and '-' key through the various selections until you have 'Game Timer' and no other text displayed.

Use the right arrow to select it. Then use the up/dn (+/-) to set the game time. In the Easy timer both sides update at the same time and can only be set to the same times.

Holding the '+' or '-' will make the timer change faster and faster.

Once you reach 25 minutes it will increment by minutes and not seconds. At this point you can simply click the pause/ start button and start your game. Make sure the toggle bar is up on the back side.

Note to reset for the next player, just toggle the 'On' button.
