

EVENT PREP - ELECTRONICS

- Get out the following documents and put them on the registration table
 - All Clocks should be set with correct time controls and ready for game start.
 - Check of all wires should be completed.
 - Clock to chess board
 - Chess board to 2-1 splitter
 - Cable under table secured to table bottom.
 - Small orange cables all connected board to board.

EVENT PREP -SOFTWARE

- Make sure the following software is up and running
 - The Caissa Pairing software.
 - DGT Live is up and running.
 - Boards have been tested (King to e4 Test)
 - You have submitted the LIVE link to chess.com
 - Chess.com will run our games live.





EVENT PREP -FACILITY

- Tables should all be lined up neatly
- Chairs all out and ready to be used.
- Placards all setup on top of tables.
- Coffee/Espresso/Tea Ready
- Paper cups Ready
- Snacks and Drinks in Fridge Ready



PRE-TOURNAMENT

ORGANIZER - Have them fill out the registration sheet in the REGISTRATION ROOM so we know they have arrived.

DIRECTOR - Paper Pairings — Post on glass wall. Announce "Pairings are up!"

The pairings will tell them which color they are, their opponent and which table number they are at. Table numbers are on placards.

Ask them to SIT and await announcements. Once quiet make pre-start announcements.

PRE-START ANNOUNCEMENTS

Tournament Organizer Announcements

- Facility information (Skittles room, store, bathroom, lounges, water, coffee, espresso, trash, etc.)
- Notable upcoming events
- · Accomplishments of players.
- Respecting the facility cleanliness. This is a place of business during work hours.
- Hygiene (hand washing etc.). A lot of hands will be shaken.
- Any Onsite Master willing to review games.
- Membership handbook, membership agreements, brochures, signups, all in registration room.
 - PGN file requests form in registration room.
- Private tournament requests, game review requests, new membership forms, etc.
- Any contests, auctions etc., that we want to make you aware of.

Tournament Director Announcements

- Official USCF Tournament Rules
- How to Contact Director during play
- Cell phone, Withdrawal, Spectator and Bye policies.

DURING THE GAME FOR TD



If a player has a concern or they/you see a rule violation, pause the clock, if player, they are to raise their hand, and concerns are expressed. As TD you may not take some form of action after which, the game is resumed.



RECORDING OFFICIAL RESULT

- **Paper recording** if the tournament is using paper pairing sheets, those sheets are usually posted in plain view. At our club, we will typically post the pairing sheets on the glass wall that separates the play area from the registration room. In this case, either player can record the result to the right of the pairing noted on the sheet.
- **Electronic pairing** if the tournament is using CaissaChess software for pairings, a computer monitor will be made available. The TD will let you know where the monitor is. In this case, the monitor will display the pairings with box fields to the right of each player's name and a list of result choices will run horizontally above the pairings. Click your result from the list of choices and then click your box field next to your name. This informs the system as to the result and the next pairing can begin.
- The printer in the office is configured with the laptop so you can print our pairings etc., from within Caissa.

Paper: They will need to wait for the paper pairings to be posted as described elsewhere.

TO CLOSE OUT EVENT
