

How to download view games being played, completed and how to download them to your computer.

1. If the club is recording the games they can be found with a delay (usually 30 minutes) on chess.com.
2. You don't need an account on chess.com to see them. Just go to chess.com and float your mouse over the binoculars on the left with the word 'Watch' to its right.
3. You will see a Gold Trophy that says 'Events.' Click on it.
4. The new screen will show on the right side, 'All Current Events' as well as Upcoming and Past. You will select either 'Current' or 'Past,' depending on whether you are looking at games being played now or looking at games already played in a completed tournament.
5. So for example, click on 'Past Events.'
6. In the Search bar, start typing the club name and you will see our tournaments that are stored on the chess.com server.
7. Select the past event you are interested in.
8. Click on the 'Games' tab. You should now see a set of darkened boards with the results in the center in white lettering.
9. On the right side, you'll see all games played in a scrollable list.
10. Find the game you are interested in and click on it.
11. The game will be presented with analysis and move by move capability. At this point you have several options:
 - a. Just review the game here at this screen.
 - b. Move the game to your Library. You will need an account to do this.
 - i. The library icon is in the lower right corner below the moves and looks like a building with pillars. Once you click on it you can create a library of your own or click on the desired library.
 - ii. The library is great if you want to download multiple files at one time.
 1. Float over 'More' on the main screen.
 2. You will see a new set of selections including 'Library.' Click on it.
 3. Click the library you are interested in.
 4. At this point you have check boxes that you can click on to select each game you want to download.
 5. Above all the checkboxes, you will see a download symbol. Click on it and all the games you selected will be placed in one file and downloaded to your computer.
 - c. Download it to your computer by clicking on the 'Share' icon. It looks like a sideways 'V' with circles on the ends and at the bottom of the 'V'.
 - i. Click the 'Download' button and it will download the PGN to a file on your computer.
