

Enrollment Leader Prayer Guide

Introduction to the Hour

This hour is an invitation to step briefly out of motion and into dependence. Whether praying alone in an office or gathered with colleagues, protect the time: close the laptop, silence notifications, dim the lights if helpful, and shut the door. Let this hour feel distinct.

If alone, resist multitasking. Sit still. Read Scripture slowly. Allow silence before speaking. If with others, begin in quiet, rotate Scripture readings, leave space for unhurried prayer, and refrain from discussion. This hour is devoted to intercession, not strategy.

Approach this time with humility and expectancy, trusting that the Lord is present and attentive.

Stillness & Surrender — 5 Minutes

Begin in silence. Invite the Lord to quiet anxious thoughts and institutional pressures. Pray for humility, softened hearts, and renewed dependence.

“Trust in the Lord with all your heart...” — Proverbs 3:5–6

Confession & Alignment — 10 Minutes

Ask where fear has driven decisions, numbers have overshadowed people, self-reliance has replaced dependence, or comparison has bred anxiety. Pray for purified motives, integrity, and courage to prioritize faithfulness.

“Search me, O God...” — Psalm 139:23–24

Prayer for Students — 15 Minutes

Pray for spiritual awakening, deep belonging, protection from despair, and clarity of calling. Lift up first-generation students, those wrestling with doubt, far from home, or facing mental health challenges.

“Let no one despise you for your youth...” — 1 Timothy 4:12

Prayer for Presidents & Leadership — 10 Minutes

Pray for wisdom in complex decisions, courage under pressure, financial provision without mission drift, unity across leadership teams, and protection from exhaustion. Ask that institutions remain Christ-centered and missionally clear.

“If any of you lacks wisdom...” — James 1:5

Prayer for Enrollment Leaders — 15 Minutes

Intercede for discernment in messaging, integrity in strategy, freedom from fear-driven urgency, protection from burnout, and attentive listening. Pray for faith over fear and trust over striving.

“Commit your work to the Lord...” — Proverbs 16:3

Dedication & Trust — 5 Minutes

Dedicate your campus and leadership to the Lord. Pray that He would establish the work of your hands and that Christ would be honored in seasons of growth and pruning. Sit in silence for one final minute before returning to your work.

“Now to Him who is able...” — Ephesians 3:20–21
