

REQUIREMENTS FOR FILM MEMBERSHIP IATSE Local 295

Thank you for your interest I.A.T.S.E. Local 295. Please read the following before filling out an application.

Basic Requirements for Film Applicants

Any applicant seeking membership in the Local must first complete a **minimum of 60 days** within the Department of application. Days are to be accrued over **three** Productions under a duly signed IATSE Collective Agreement. (feature films and/or MOW's and/or episodic television series) worked under at least three different Department Heads.

You must work **a minimum of 20** days on one of the shows, and **one** of the shows must be a **different format** (e.g.: if two of your shows are MOW's, the third must be an episodic television series **or** a Feature film.)

Consideration may be given on the number of different Department Heads if requested.

An equivalent amount of time worked in a relevant area and/or 'special skills' outside Local 295 *may* be considered to fulfill the requirement.

Applicants to I.A.T.S.E. are expected to be of good moral character.

Each application must include:

- □ A completed IATSE membership application form.
- An application request to the Secretary of IATSE Local 295.
- □ Copies of three completed evaluation or recommendation forms completed by three different Department Heads.
- A personal resume indicating past experience in a related field.
- Proof of residency in the form of a photocopy of a Saskatchewan Health Care Card.
- Photocopy of any educational certificate/license applicable to the applied position.
- □ Photocopy of a valid Saskatchewan Drivers License.
- Proof of completion of a Set Protocol/Set Safety Course. (or proof of enrollment in the next course offered)
- □ \$150.00 application fee

Financial Obligations of Membership

Membership dues are \$360.00 per year (\$324.00 if the entire year is paid before Jan 1st) \$90.00 each quarter; payable on Jan.1st, April 1st, July 1st, and Oct. 1st) PLUS an additional 2.5% check off fee deducted from earnings on each paycheque.

Note:

Specific Departmental requirements may apply.

Applications can take up to four months to process. You will be notified once your application has been reviewed.
