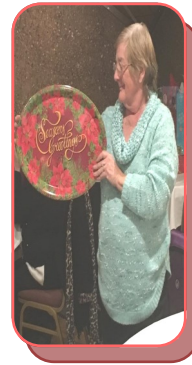
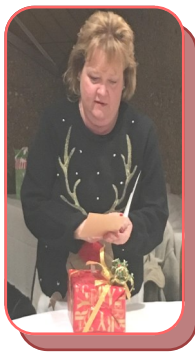


Hello Club Members,
