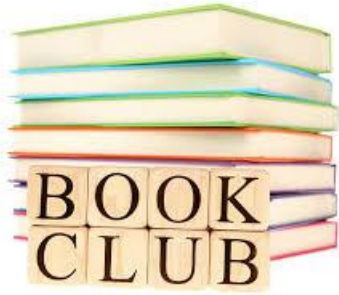
If you are planning on ordering from Flower Power please let Cheri S. know by April 9. If everyone orders together, you can save on shipping costs.
