Scholarship Eligibility Requirements: Applicants must:

- Reside in Pleasant Prairie, WI
- Be a current High School Senior, graduating in Spring of 2024
- Have a minimum 2.8 GPA on a 4.0 unweighted scale (or equivalent)
- Provide a copy of their High School Transcript through the first grading period of their Senior year
- Submit at least two (2) letters of recommendation with the completed application from responsible adults who know the applicant well, excluding any family members
- Submit a personal statement which has a minimum of 200 typewritten words
- Submit all application answers either printed or typed in blue or black ink and single sided document only.

Judging Criteria:

Your application will be screened by the PPWC Education Committee. The committee members will review each submitted application carefully and give each application thorough consideration. Applicants will be scored on the following:

- Academic Achievement
- Leadership and Character
- Community Service Participation
- Financial Need

To be considered for this scholarship, return the following items to the address below:

- Completed application, including any additional pages
- High School Transcripts
- (2) Letters of recommendation from responsible adults who know you well, excluding any family members
