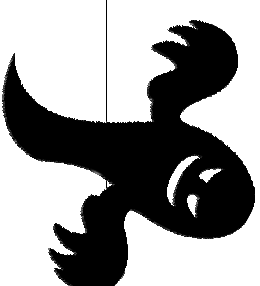
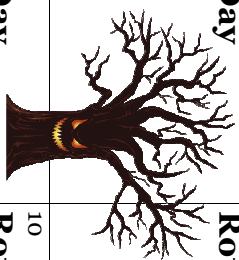

We are currently searching for individuals that would like to Volunteer at the Thrift Shoppe.

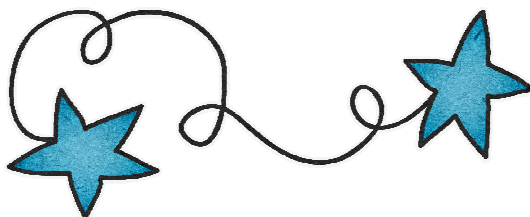

## IT'S THAT TIME OF YEAR AGAIN!

OCT. 15 – DEC. 7

**That's right! It is time to schedule a review of your Medicare Part D drug plans that will be effective January 1, 2019**

**You should do a review of your prescription drug plan each and every year!!!**

### Why?

- 1 You may be taking new or different medications than you were last year.
- 2 Your plan may have changed the copay on the medications you take.
- 3 Your plan may not cover the same drugs next year.
- 4 There may be a plan that offers a lower copay for your medications.
- 5 The plan premiums usually change each year.

These are all good reasons to review your plans each year.

- You can see if your plan will be making changes by looking over the Formulary you get in the mail from your plan each year;

### Or....

-You can do a search on your own at [www.Medicare.gov](http://www.Medicare.gov). Click on "Find Health & Drug Plans";

### Or....

-You can call the Area Agency on Aging to find the enrollment event that is nearest to you and call to make an appointment with a SHIIP counselor;

### Or....

-You can make an appointment with a SHIIP counselor at the Area Agency on Aging in North Platte.

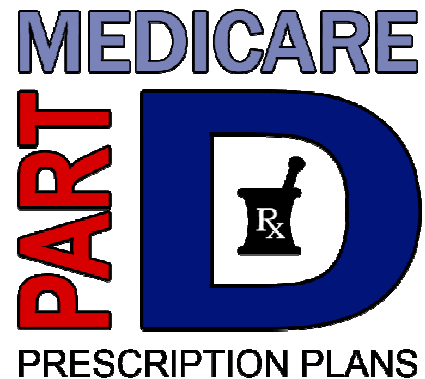
-A fifth option would be to call 1-800-Medicare and enroll over the phone.
