#### CHANGES IN MEDICARE SUPPLEMENTS

Beginning in 2020, Medigap plans can no longer offer plans that cover the Part B deductible. Due to this change, Plans C and F will no longer be sold as of 2020. These are the only plans that cover the Part B deductible.

Beneficiaries who have a Plan F or C now will be able to keep the plan in 2020 and beyond, however no new plans for F or C will be sold starting in 2020.

Since the beneficiary is NOT losing coverage, they will NOT get a guarantee issue into a different plan. Companies may choose to offer a guarantee issue to take another plan with their company but they are not required to do so. Companies can dictate which plan a beneficiary could change to.

In 2020, Plans D and G will be the most comparable option to the plans no longer offered. The only difference in them and the C and F plans is the Part B deductible.


With these changes occurring, this could be a prime opportunity for beneficiaries to be targeted.


