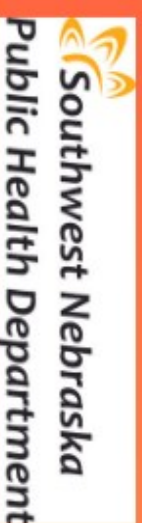
Winter squash comes in all shapes, sizes & colors. Common varieties include pumpkin, acorn squash, butternut squash and spaghetti squash.
