

Honda techs I have talked to say there is a special additive in the oil from the factory and never change it early. What does A17 mean on Honda Civic? A17 is for oil change, tire rotation, and brake fluid replacement. What does b14 mean on Honda Civic? It's in the owners manual! Replace engine oil and oil filter. Check front and rear brakes. Check pads and discs for wear (thickness), damage, and cracks. Check calipers for damage, leaks, and tightness of mounting bolts. What does A123 mean on Honda Civic? Only show this user. Recommended Services Hi There, Service code A13 relates to the following: A = Replace engine oil 1 = Rotate tires 3 = Replace transmission oil 1 would recommend having a professional from Yourmechanic come to your location to perform these services if you are not able to perform them. How do I reset my A13 Service code? This method should work on any Honda trim model that has a touch screen with a home screen. Press home. Select settings. Press vehicle settings. Scroll down to maintenance info and press it to select it. Press reset. A screen will pop up asking if you really want to reset it or cancel, press reset and that should do it. How many miles can you drive after maintenance light comes on Honda? With that said if you want just do the oil change and rotate the tires yourself to save money just ask them how much they would charge to do the "9" part of it. As I said in another thread it's important to do scheduled maintenance to avoid costly repairs in the future especially in regards to the braking system. For the fluid change I think Hondas interval is every three years regardless of mileage, maybe this first service is for a break in period? No idea. If you want to further save money take it to your mechanic and ask them to do the service as Honda advises.
