ORDINANCE 2023- 430

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE NO. 2020-408 CONCERNING THE LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY CAUSED BY COVID-19, AND TO RE-INSTATE ALL ORDINANCES SUSPENDED BY NO. 2020-408

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 408 was adopted April 6, 2020, and provided the Mayor with emergency powers for the initial 60 days; and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois continues to operate under a state of emergency initially declared by Governor Pritzker; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Naplate does not expect any matters requiring emergency powers at the local level that were provided by the adoption of Ordinance No. 408.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council of the Village of Naplate, LaSalle County, Illinois, as follows:

ARTICLE 1:

The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby incorporated as findings of fact as if said recitals were fully set forth herein.

ARTICLE 2:

That Ordinance No. 408 is hereby rescinded and vacated effective upon the adoption of this ordinance.


ARTICLE 3:

ARTICLE 4:

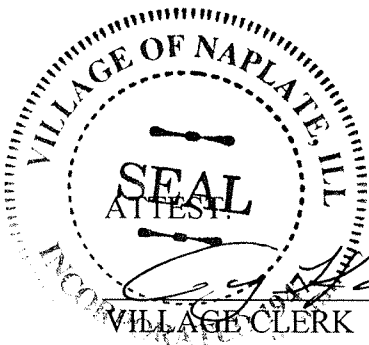
This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
