2025 Show Rules and Regulations

Open Halter: Open to all ponies, horses and yearlings. To be judged for overall confirmation and correctness. Can be presented in halter or bridle.

<u>W/T/C Pleasure Division</u> (classes 21, 22, 23) can be ridden in Western or English. Except for over fences class must be English. Pattern will be posted.

<u>Warm Up Red/Blue</u> (classes WU1, WU2) will now be judged and ribboned at the gate if your score constitutes a 1st or 2nd place. A first place ribbon is awarded for 80+ points and 70-79 points will be for a second place ribbon.

Short / Long Stirrup Equitation (classes 48, 49, 50) open to all riders and ponies who have not competed over 2'3". 18" verticals, no oxers.

<u>Open Schooling Hunter 18"</u> (classes 9, 10, 11) are open to young and inexperienced horses and riders. No oxers. May be ridden by pro or amateur riders.

Must ride in both <u>Jumpers (Crossrails, 2', 2'3", 2'6", 2'9" and Up)</u> classes <u>(clean/jump off AND power & speed)</u> to be eligible for Grand and Reserve Championships* and year-end awards and prizes. (classes 7, 8, 5, 6, 3, 4, 25, 26)

Modified Hunter 2'3" (classes 12, 13, 14) are open to all horses, ponies, and riders.

<u>All Specialty Highlighted</u> classes (OH, EC, JC, MM) are pinned through 8th place and are individually eligible for year-end awards and prizes.

<u>All Open Height Card</u> (classes JC, MM) MUST be run during the height that the rider entered before the fence height is changed. Heights are 18" and up. No crossrails in the main ring.

Equitation Division 2'6" (classes 18,19) to be judged one flat and one over fence course. Eligible for Grand and Reserve. Open to all horses and ponies.

JACKPOT

All Jackpot classes (EC, JC, and MM) receive ribbons for places 1st through 8th. WINNER TAKES ALL, which will be \$100 credited to their show bill. 2nd and 3rd place winners will receive one free warm up card and can be redeemed at any show during the 2025 season. The class MUST have a minimum of 6 riders for pay out of prize money.

<u>Open High Hunters 2'6" and Up</u> (classes 15, 16, 17) are open to all horses, ponies, and riders. Please specify height you want to jump at registration, 2'6", 2'9", 3' or higher. Will be judged all on the same card as one. Lower height will go first.

<u>Walk Division</u> (classes 33, 34, 35, 36) are open to all inexperienced horses and riders in their first year of showing. Trainers are allowed in arena with horse on/off lead-line. Class 36 is not required for championship but offers bonus points for year-end points.

<u>Walk Trot All Ages</u> (classes 37, 38, 39, 40) can be ridden by any horse and rider combination for year-end points. Can ride in everything under 18". Class 40 is not required for championship but offers bonus points for year-end points.

<u>Walk Trot Crossrails</u> (classes 30, 31, 32) can be ridden by any horse and rider combination. Can cross-enter in anything under 2'.

<u>Beginner Novice Hunter Walk/Trot Crossrails</u> (classes 41, 42, 43) can be ridden by pro or amateur riders. Open to all horses and ponies in the first 2 years of showing.

<u>Open Crossrails Hunter</u> (classes 27, 28, 29) can be ridden by any rider (amateur or pro) as points follow the horse for year-end awards and prizes. Can cross-enter in anything under 2'. Must canter on the flat. Can trot in or canter out on fences. Simple changes allowed.

<u>Green Horse Crossrails</u> (classes 45, 46, 47) are open to all inexperienced horses and ponies showing in their first two years. Can be ridden by any rider as points follow the horse for year-end awards and prizes. Can cross-enter in anything under 2'. Must canter on the flat. Can trot or canter the crossrails. Simple changes allowed.

*Grand and Reserve Championship ribbons are awarded ONLY when there are three entries in each class of that division. And don't forget to pick a prize!

*Year End Awards must compete in at least 4 of the 6 shows to qualify for that division and or specialty class.
