

Instructions for Nomination Petitions

2024 Officers Election

Nominations are now welcome for the officers of Local 31: President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer. The new officers will take office on October 1, 2024, and serve until September 30, 2027. Duties of the officers are described in Section 8.11 of the NABET Constitution and in Article III of the Local 31 By-Laws. The President of Local 31 will also serve as a delegate to the NABET-CWA Conference and the CWA Conventions while in office.

The nominating petitions are available on the NABET Local 31 web site or by calling the Local 31 Office (301/459-4999). The Local 31 Office can also respond to questions about qualifications to run for office, or the duties and responsibilities of each officer, or the compensation paid to each officer.

RULES

1. The Nominee shall be a member-in-good-standing of NABET-CWA Local 31 and shall sign the petition indicating a willingness to serve if elected.
2. Nominating petitions shall be signed by at least 25 members-in-good-standing of NABET-CWA Local 31.
3. Nominating petitions must be returned to the Local 31 Office by 3:00 p.m. on Monday, July 1, 2024. Photocopies (PDF's) will be accepted on that date by 3:00 pm, but the original documents must be delivered to the office no later than 3:00 pm on July 8, 2024.
4. Each candidate may submit one page of campaign information (text only) to be distributed with the ballots. This literature must be submitted to the Local 31 Office in "camera-ready" form no later than 3:00 pm on Monday, July 1, 2024.
5. Ballots will be distributed on Monday, August 5, 2024, and must be received in the Post Office Box by 12 noon on August 28, 2024.
6. Election will be by majority of those voting. In the event that no candidate receives a majority of the votes cast, a run-off election will be held.
