RENOVATION OF PARK FACILITIES

Recently the township requested quotes for the resurfacing of the basketball and tennis courts at the recreation park off Mayfield Road. Two companies looked at the site and recommended since the courts were 28 years old and the asphalt was failing to remove the old courts and construct new ones. The trustees decided to change one tennis court into two pickleball to the courts. The site would then have basketball, tennis and pickleball for our residents.

Due to the cost, trustees have decided to apply for a Land & Water Conservation Fund Grant through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for the construction of the courts at the recreational park. One requirement for receiving a grant is to conduct a survey. A survey is on our website **huntsburgtownship.com** and we would appreciate residents to complete the few questions.

The questions are:

- Have you ever used the Huntsburg Township Recreational Park on Mayfield Road?
- How often do you use the Huntsburg Township Recreational Park on Mayfield Road?
- Are you in support of the Township upgrading and improving the basketball and tennis courts at the Recreational Park on Mayfield Road?
- Would you like to see Pickleball added to the courts at the Recreational Park on Mayfield Road?
- Are you in support of the Township applying for a grant to subsidize the cost of the improvements to the Recreational Park on Mayfield Road?
- Do you have any other sports-related activities you would like to see at the Recreational Park on Mayfield Road?

TOWNSHIP RECREATIONAL PARK PROPERTY REGULATIONS

Hunting is strictly forbidden on Huntsburg Township Properties. There have been hunters shooting at wildlife in the Recreational Park during hours the park is being enjoyed by others and maintained by our township employees. Hunting violations will be referred to the Game Warden and prosecution may be involved.

Signs are posted at the park entrance noting park open hours. The park opens at dawn and closes at dusk. NO ONE should be in the park after dusk. No late night parties.

No ATV's, dirt bikes, snowmobiles or other off road vehicles are permitted in the park.

MAILBOXES

The township policy on replacing mailboxes during winter months is only to replace boxes that have been struck by the plow or truck. Mailboxes that go down due to heavy snow will not be replaced. Boxes are replaced with an inexpensive, simple type box only. Please consult your postmaster for regulation regarding the installation of a mailbox.

CLEAN OUT YOUR DRIVEWAY CULVERTS

Landowners have the responsibility to keep their driveway culvert clean and free of debris. The biggest assistance a resident can be to the township is to make sure your driveway culvert is clean. Cleaning out your culvert will allow for the continuous flow of water through the ditches and will aid to control flooding and road erosion.

ROADS IMPROVEMENTS

Crack sealing, ditching, grading and applying gravel are ongoing maintenance services. Please bear with our crews during the changing seasons as roads tend to deteriorate at that time. Be aware Huntsburg Township will not pay for car repairs or blown tires due to road conditions. Drivers must drive according to road conditions. That means drive a little slower to avoid road hazards; speed limits are posted on all roads. Road Crew members ask for all buggy drivers not to drive through a freshly filled pot hole. The asphalt material needs to dry and cure. Tracks through the freshly filled hole will not allow the asphalt to cure. This results in another pothole.

This year the township has completed two road projects thanks to the passing of the 3.0 mill Road & Bridge Levy last year. The Overlook Knoll Subdivision roads were completely reconstructed due to failing asphalt and no cement stabilization when first constructed. The cost was near \$800,000. We were able to use some of the American Recovery Act funds we received.

East Pioneer Road had old dust control ground along with several tons of asphalt grindings and road materials added. The road was then topped with dust control consisting of MC70 and stone. This fall a second layer of dust control and stone was added. The trustees have decided if this road maintenance holds up well we may do other road maintenance the same where needed.

REDUCE — REUSE — RECYCLE

Our camera system is able to obtain license plates and driver's face and we have been successful in catching persons dumping unacceptable debris. The sheriff's department contacts them and makes them remove the unwanted items. Most perpetrators have not been Huntsburg residents. So BEWARE we are watching. Only items listed on the containers are permitted in the bins. Not everything is recyclable. NO TRASH ALLOWED. NO PLASTIC BAGS PLEASE. They jam the machinery.

Paper and cardboard products should be placed in the paper recycling bins. Shredded paper is accepted in clear plastic bags. Please put a small hole in the bag to allow air to escape but not the paper. Thanks so much for recycling with us. Please keep our recycling center clean.

ZONING

Zoning applications are available in the foyer of the town hall. The foyer is always open. If you are in need of a zoning permit please pick one up at the town hall, complete the application and call the office for an appointment. Our Zoning Inspector, Paul Tucker will call you and schedule an appointment.


