ZONING:

Zoning Inspector Paul Tucker is available by appointment for your zoning permits, exemptions, conditional use permits and variances. He may be reached by calling the Township offices at 636-5486 ext. 3. Please leave a message and he will return your call. **Please be advised zoning permits are required for all your building projects even agricultural buildings.** Some may be exempt from fees but still require you to submit an application. The Township doesn't know what you are constructing if an application is not submitted.

Please make sure you call the office for information or visit <u>Huntsburg Township Zoning Resolution 2021 (oh.gov)</u> for a complete copy of the Zoning Resolution and forms. Forms are also available in the Town Hall foyer and the Township website.

CEMETERY:

Maintenance will be cleaning the cemetery and preparing it for Memorial Day. If you have any items you wish to keep please remove them. All old wreaths and unsightly items left at the graveside will be discarded.

No plantings are permitted. Artificial flowers or ornaments are permitted on the graves until they become weather beaten. The Township is not responsible for damage or theft of such items and may remove them if they become unsightly.

A NOTE FROM THE FISCAL OFFICER — MICHELE A. SAUNDERS

The Township has received a \$1000.00 grant from our insurance company OTARMA for a new AED unit for the community center.

The Township has received a Sponsorship Grant from NOPEC in the amount of \$1000 this money has been allocated to the Huntsburg Pumpkin Festival. An application is in process to obtain a NOPEC Energized Community Grant in the amount of \$3611 for replacement windows at the town hall.

Grant funding has been secured from Geauga Trumbull Solid Waste District for GO GREEN for our Trash clean up day on June 8 in the amount of \$3,050. A tire recycling grant for \$1616.00 was also approved.

RECYCLING 5 Ways to Recycle Right — Geauga Trumbull Solid Waste District

- 1. **Leave recyclables loose not bagged.** Plastic bags do not belong in your recycling bin or cart. Plastic bags get tangled in the sorting machines at the recycling facilities and cause major problems for the recycling process. Plastic shopping bags can be recycled at many retail locations, including Giant Eagle, Lowe's Home Improvement, Marc's, Target and Walmart stores.
- 2. **Make sure it's clean and empty.** Rinse residue from cartons, containers, bottles and jars or any other recyclable that may contain food particles. Greasy pizza boxes are not accepted.
- 3. **Keep it dry.** When it comes to paper and cardboard, keeping it dry is imperative for the recycling process. Please flatten all cardboard boxes as well.
- 4. **Don't wish cycle.** Think you can throw everything into your recycling bin and it will get sorted out at the recycling plant? Think again. Recycling only these five core items is paramount: cans, cartons, glass bottles and jars, paper and boxes along with plastic bottles and jugs.

Recreational Cannabis

On November 7, 2023 voters in Ohio approved State Issue 2, which enacted new Chapter 3780 of the Ohio Revised Code which regulates and authorizes recreational adult use of cannabis in the state of Ohio. Huntsburg Township Board of Trustees by unanimous vote passed a resolution to prohibit adult use cannabis operators within the unincorporated area of Huntsburg Township.

ROAD WORKS

Crews will continue to work on all Township roads. Roads will be sprayed with dust control only where needed later this summer. We ask our Amish Community to limit the use of horse and buggies while the application cures. The horses shoes put holes in the fresh dust control causing damage to the road surface. Please observe posted speed signs and slow down near broken road surface areas. During dusty times please watch for pedestrians and slow moving vehicles.

Major road construction will be underway this summer in the Overlook Subdivision with the repaving of Zrolka Drive and Alexander Court.

Pioneer Road east of Hayes will also under go major reconstruction as we reestablish a crown and base to that section of the road.

Residents are responsible for keeping their drive pipes clean and free of debris. Please clean out pipes to keep the ditches flowing. Dumping of unwanted items on Township roads is illegal.

Please call and report any serious road problem, flooding on roads, fallen limbs or other hazard we should be aware of. You may leave a message at 440-636-5486 option 1.

What open burning is never allowed?

Under Ohio law, these materials *may not* be burned anywhere in the state at any time:

- garbage—any wastes created in the process of handling, preparing, cooking or consuming food;
- materials containing rubber, grease and asphalt or made from petroleum, such as tires, cars and auto parts, plastics or plastic- coated wire; and
- dead animals unless approved for control of disease by a governing agency.

To obtain a list of open fires that are allowed in Ohio please contact the OEPA (614) 644-2270.

Middlefield Volunteer Fire Department will still issue burn permits for anyone following the regulations. Permits are issued after fire personnel have inspected the location for safety. Call them at 440-632-1907 a non-emergency number. Currently there is a burn ban issued by the state until May 31.
