L1 Class Flags

Division 1	Flag R
Division 2 (one design, S80 fleet)	Flag T
Division 3 (Pursuit races)	Flag E

L2 Crew Declaration link – As nominated in the Standard Sailing Instructions

L3 The Courses

Courses shall be selected from current version of the Standard Sailing Instruction - Attachment 1 – Courses and Marks.

Competitors should be aware of the shipping movements that can occur at any time and are reminded to keep clear of shipping within Hobsons Bay and the Williamstown and Port Melbourne Channels.

All boats are referred to Clause 9 (Safety Regulations) of the Primary Sailing Instructions

While Channel Marks 71, 11, 9 are not marks of the course in terms of RRS 28.1, these are **passing** marks under RRS 28.2 and therefore have a required side as indicated in the course descriptions.

A boat shall not pass through any finish line except when finishing her race, unless nominated in course. Any boat doing so will be scored DSQ without hearing. This changes RRS 63.1, A4 and A5.

After starting, the imaginary line between the RMYS H mark and the RMYS Tower is an obstruction. It shall remain an obstruction until all boats have finished.

All divisions start at the same start line. Divisions 2 and 3 have the same start and finish location.

L4 The Start

L4.1 Divisions 1 and 2

Refer Primary Sailing Instructions 6.0

Start location to be in the vicinity of Ch marks 73 and 74.

The warning signal for Division 1 shall be as published in the Notice of Race. Division 2 is approx. 20 minutes later.

The starting line shall be a line between the staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee Vessel and an orange buoy.

A crowding mark (orange with a black band) may be laid adjacent to the Race Committee Boat. When laid, boats shall not sail between the crowding mark and the Race Committee Boat.

Only Division 1 boats intending to race shall ‘sign on’ by sailing on a starboard tack past the stern of its Race Committee Vessel prior to the first warning signal for Division 1, hail her sail number, and receive acknowledgment from the Race Committee Vessel.

L4.2 Division 3 (Pursuit Race).

Refer Primary Sailing Instructions 6.0

Start location to be in the vicinity of Ch marks 73 and 74.

The warning signal for Division 3 may be 10 minutes after Division 2 start.

The starting line shall be a line between the staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee Vessel and an orange buoy.

A crowding mark (orange with a black band) may be laid adjacent to the Race Committee Boat. When laid, boats shall not sail between the crowding mark and the Race Committee Boat.

The appropriate start time for each group is an expression of time in minutes after the primary starting signal and shall be displayed at two-minute intervals. The start for the group indicated by the numeral is signaled by the removing of the numeral.

Pursuit entrants who chose not to use a spinnaker may not use spinnakers. Normal working sails may be poled out.

Pursuit entrants who choose to use a spinnaker shall start 4 minutes later than their allocated non-spinnaker handicap.

Yachts must advise the Race Committee on VHF Ch 69 between 1310hrs and 1320hrs that they intend to use a spinnaker.

When 'Pursuit Race' starts apply a boat's preparatory signal is **deemed made** four minutes before the boat's starting time. **Note: Flag "P" will not be displayed.**

The starting procedure is as follows and continues through each group:

L5 Shortening Course

The Race Committee may shorten the course in all or specific Divisions by deleting a mark of the course and advising via VHF channel 69. Should it be required the Race Officer will also advise of a change in finishing direction. Refer to Clause 3, Primary Sailing Instructions.

L6 The Finish

Division 1- The finish line is between the Vertical line on the RMYS Tower and the center of RMYS Mark A. Boats shall not pass between RMYS Mark H and the RMYS Tower, even after finishing.

Division 2 and 3 - The finishing line will be between the staff displaying a blue flag on the Race Committee Vessel at the starboard end and the course side of the 'port end' finishing mark an orange buoy or nearby fixed mark.

L7 Scoring

The following discards shall apply to a boat's series score.

- Discard one worst score after completion of four races.
- Discard two worst scores after completion of eight races.

L8 Time Limit

For all Divisions the time limit for all boats to sail the course and finish is 1630.

Any boats still racing when her time limit expires will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF) without hearing. This changes RRS 35, 63.1, A4 and A5.

L9 Prizes

The Brass Monkey Series Trophy will be given to the first placed boat on PHS in Division 1.

Brass Monkey Series S80 Trophy will be given to the first placed S80 in Div 2.

Brass Monkey Series Pursuit Trophy will be given to the first pursuit boat.

Additional prizes may be given at the discretion of Hobsons Bay Yacht Club, Royal Melbourne Yacht Squadron and Royal Yacht Club of Victoria.
