'As Many as You Can Race'

I1. Rules

Social distancing (1.5m) must be adhered to while sailing for 90% of the time (Hiking/sitting shoulder to shoulder on the rail/ in the cockpit is NOT acceptable).

Masks must always be worn (both on and off the water), unless sailing single-handed or with someone from your place of residence.

Where adults over 18 years of age are sailing with children 18 and under, then the social distancing rule of 1.5 meters applies

13. The Courses

Refer to the 'Marks' document, Attachment 1 of the Sailing Instructions

Course 1. Start in the vicinity of Ch 71

Start in a Southerly direction - Gellibrand Shoal Mark to starboard - Outer Anchorage to port - Spoil Ground to Port - HBYC Club House finish.

Course 2. Start in the vicinity of Ch 71

Round windward yellow mark to starboard - Gellibrand Shoal Mark to starboard - Outer Anchorage to port - Spoil Ground to Port - HBYC Club House finish.

Course 3. Start in the vicinity of Ch 71

Round windward yellow mark to port - Gellibrand Shoal Mark to starboard - Outer Anchorage to port - Spoil Ground to Port - HBYC Club House finish.

14. The Finish

Competitors shall notify the Race Officer as they approach the Williamstown Breakwater on the applicable VHF Channel (ref. Radio Communication in Sailing Instructions 9.0)

Competitors are advised to also record their own Finish Times

15. Time Limit

The time limit for the first boat to sail the Course and Finish shall be 17:00. If no boat finishes within the time limit the race shall be abandoned. Boats still racing after 18:00 shall be scored Did Not Finish (DNF) without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A4 and A5

I6. Prizes

Prizes may be given at the discretion of Hobsons Bay Yacht Club
