

Appendix B:

Chris Webb Two-Handed Series

B1. Rules

The use of self-steering is permitted. This changes RRS 52.

B2. Class Flags

Combined Fleet Flag R

B3. The Courses

Refer to the 'Marks' document attachment 1 for mark locations.

Competitors should be aware of the shipping movements that can occur at any time and are reminded to keep clear of shipping within Hobsons Bay and the Williamstown and Port Melbourne Channels.

Course 1. Start between RMYS C and Start/Committee boat.

Start in a Southerly direction - Gellibrand Shoal Mark to starboard - Outer Anchorage to port - Spoil Ground to Port - HBYC Club House finish.

Course 2. Start between RMYS C and Start/Committee boat.

Round windward yellow mark to starboard - Gellibrand Shoal Mark to starboard - Outer Anchorage to port - Spoil Ground to Port - HBYC Club House finish.

Course 3. Start between RMYS C and Start/Committee boat.

Round windward yellow mark to port - Gellibrand Shoal Mark to starboard - Outer Anchorage to port - Spoil Ground to Port - HBYC Club House finish.

B4. The Finish

Competitors shall notify Hobsons Bay Base as they approach the Williamstown Breakwater on VHF Channel 69.

Competitors are advised to also record their own Finish Times

B5. Time Limit

The time limit for the first boat to sail the Course and Finish shall be 17:00. If no boat finishes within the time limit the race shall be abandoned. Boats still racing after 18:00 shall be scored Did Not Finish (DNF) without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A4 and A5

B6. Safety

It is compulsory for all crew to always wear Life Jackets during Two-Handed races.

B7. Prizes

The Bernie Kavanaugh Trophy (PHS) and Jessie Cup (AMS) - race one and Acrospire Trophy (PHS) race five shall be given to the first HBYC boat in both PHS and AMS respectively entered in the Two-Handed Series.

A Two-Handed Series Trophy shall be given to the first boat in each PHS, AMS and ORC_AP (Endorsed) Divisions.

Additional prizes may be given at the discretion of Hobsons Bay Yacht Club.
