The UV Box: Operating Information and Warranty

No Learning Curve!

- 1) Clean visible dirt, moisture or liquid residue from items to be sanitized as per manufacturer's instructions.
- 2) Place item in the KR615 Germicidal Enclosure. For items with cords (or leads) that must remain connected, thread the cord through the unit's Wire Routing System.
- 3) When sanitizing multiple items, do not stack or allow sides of items to touch.
- 4) Close the door and turn knob to lock. Press the red button to begin the decontamination cycle.
- 5) When the red button and LED indicator turn off, remove item(s) and use normally.



Place any item inside The UV Box without stacking or overlapping



Wire Routing System accommodates items that must remain connected



Close the door and turn knob to lock



Press the red button to begin the disinfection cycle

Note: Covered surfaces not contacted by the UV light will not be disinfected
