MISSION OF COGNITIVE DISSIDENTS* “INTEREST GROUP” (EXPANDED)

- Increase voter turnout in support of the United States Constitution and Western Civilization.
Examples: Provide forums for discussion and debate,
Promote constructive solutions benefiting all citizens,
Support constitutional policies and candidates
- Provide a resource for intelligent, balanced analysis of important issues facing Sun City, Williamson County, Texas, and the USA.
Example: Power Point Research Project, 10/19/2023, Missouri et al vs Biden
- Manage and facilitate formal, fair, balanced debate of important issues in Sun City and Williamson County.
Example: Community Forum at Georgetown Public Library
- Change hearts, minds and votes by reaching out to those on the other side of the political fence.
Example: Sponsor and drive letters to the editor in local newspapers
- Provide systems analysis when requested by affiliated groups.
Example: Analyze voting patterns or processes and propose tactics to increase early voting percentages and total vote
- Engage and counter biased partisan groups which limit free speech to promote Totalitarian (Fascistic, Communist, Jihadist), and divisive anti-American lectures disguised as conversations or discussions.
