



What is going on with China?

**NOT ALL IS AS IT SEEMS TO BE. MAJOR FORCES ARE
SHAKING THE FOUNDATION OF THE PEOPLES REPUBLIC.**

Is China a Good Global Citizen?

- ▶ China still has not come clean on its Covid 19 response. It is suspected that its response and the international exposure through Chinese “tourist” may have been an act of economic war and not an accident.
- ▶ It has not complied with international Climate agreements to which it is a signatory party.
- ▶ It has not complied with WTO Court directives on trade and honoring patents and forbidding government subsidies of industry or product dumping.
- ▶ Its Belt and Road initiative has led to heavy handedness in underdeveloped countries causing many to revolt against the presence of CCP troops in their countries. .

Is China a Good Global Citizen?

- ▶ It has repeatedly violated international agreements including its Hong Kong transfer from England which saw it quickly integrate governance to Communist control far earlier than the agreed upon transition date defined in the treaty.
- ▶ China has repeatedly signed international trade and climate agreements with no apparent intent to abide by the restrictions proscribed in those agreements, ignoring patent and copyright laws, directly supporting companies, dumping products and ignoring climate treaty controls.
- ▶ China has been the world's largest manufacturer and distributor of fentanyl, frequently using drug cartels to transport and distribute fentanyl in violation of international treaties.
- ▶ China continues to persecute ethnic and religious minorities.
- ▶ China continues to “mine” minorities for organs to sell on the international black market and is a major source of fentanyl.
- ▶ China continues to aggressively expand its military and geographic sphere of influence in contradiction of international law and standards. For instance, its aggressive creation of naval bases in the South China Sea outside of UN recognized territorial waters and provocative military challenges to the Phillipino Navy and territorial waters.

Is China a good global citizen?

- ▶ It has aggressively threatened and saber rattled against the new Japanese Premier and her policies. These threats are both targeting Japan and making personal threats against her.
- ▶ Evidence suggests its possible interference in the 2020 US Presidential Election where 10s of thousands of preprinted ballots were reportedly shipped into NYC for transfer to Pennsylvania.
- ▶ Its refusal to share information on its handling of COVID: its probable production in Chinese labs, its slowness to alert international healthcare and its spread across international borders, - all of which suggest a premeditated action to impact international economies. In essence – an act of chemical warfare.
- ▶ China has the initiator of state sponsored warfare in Korea, Viet Nam and Cambodia.

How Did We Get Here?

- ▶ Nixon sought to break down China's Communist government by incorporating it into the world stage in the hopes that it would become interdependent and move to a free market economy.
- ▶ Giving it Most Favored Nation Status in the WTO.
- ▶ Supporting private financial aid and investment to build China's economy.
- ▶ Supported Communist China's admission into the UN and a permanent seat on the Security Council as a replacement for Taiwan.
- ▶ Allowed the myth of Mao's defeat of the Japanese Army in WW2 to become the de facto historical narrative.
- ▶ Subsequent administration's have expanded the effort despite China's belligerent policies.

How Did We Get Here?

- ▶ Subsequent administration's have expanded the effort despite China's billigerent policies.
 - ▶ Clinton's State Department's approval of the selling of US missile guidance technology to China.
 - ▶ Supporting restrictive mining regulations which led to the Transferring US sourcing of rare metals to China.
 - ▶ Allowing, if not supporting the manufacture of pharmaceuticals from US based to Chinese sources.
 - ▶ Collaborating with China on gain of function research which led to The Covid 19 epidemic.
 - ▶ Working with British financial interest who have sought to maintain England's synthetic Commonwealth through globalist trade policies.

Political Infighting

- ▶ Xi JiPing is battling with the Chinese People's Army for control. He has demoted and imprisoned many popular generals which are not aligned with him. Many have been charged with corruption and imprisoned.
- ▶ It has been rumored that Xi JiPing had formed a shadow force to protect him in the event of a coup and take over the government. Just before October's Plenum, nine major military officers were purged - arrested, suspended from the CPA and the CCP on charges of corruption.
- ▶ Xi JiPing's loyalist entourage has shrunk and some reformist members of the CCP have been elevated in leadership ranks.
- ▶ Government funded exhibits which honored his father and rehabilitated his reputation following his imprisonment during the 1970's Cultural Revolution.
- ▶ Rumors about Xi Ji Ping's health have been repeatedly released.
- ▶ Xi Ji Ping's policies are being blamed for the flame out of China's economy.
- ▶ Rumors about corruption by Xi Ji Ping's wife and daughter are rampant.

An Economy in Tatters -1.

- ▶ Thrump's Tariffs have crushed China's economy.
 - ▶ Factories are closing.
 - ▶ Unemployment is skyrocketing and 10s of millions are living on the streets
 - ▶ Once thriving shopping centers and other retail are boarded up.
- ▶ China's claimed 5% YOY GDP growth was a chimera based on government spending.
- ▶ China's economy lacks the consumer spending safety valve that the US and its market driven economy has .
- ▶ Chinese citizens are leaving the cites and returning to the country.
- ▶ The Chinese drive to replace the US Dollar as the Currency of Record (BREXIT) has failed.
- ▶ China's move to close rare metals exports to the US robs it of badly needed currency and will accelerate the US drive to mine its own resources.



An Economy in Tatters - 2.

- ▶ Real Estate giants have gone or are going bankrupt, crushing individual savings. 100 million apartment units stand empty. Jing Jin Newtown, a 20 year old vast luxury villa community is abandoned.
- ▶ Recent college graduates cannot find jobs and are forced to live on the streets and those with jobs are crushed with 996 employment policies.
- ▶ Millions of workers have been terminated without being compensated for earned income already several months in arrears.
- ▶ Its costly Belt and Road initiative is failing as many countries are pushing back against China's strong arm policies.
- ▶ Chinese currency is being rejected internationally by the private sector.
- ▶ The Chinese tourism industry (airlines, hotels, etc.) is suffering from reduced international tourists.



A Crumbling Infrastructure

- ▶ China's "miracle cities" lie dormant and unoccupied as they crumble from "criminal" construction and lack of maintenance.
- ▶ Cracks are appearing in the Three River Dam signaling the possibility of a cataclysmic failure which could flood at least three major downstream cities.
- ▶ Retail and apartment skyscrapers, once the symbol of China's economic "miracle" are so poorly built that they are literally crumbling into the streets.
- ▶ China's airports and subways, once thriving with international business travelers and tourists are "ghost towns" which threaten the financial viability of China's airlines.
- ▶ Food shortages and overpriced items are being reported across the country.
- ▶ In the recent months, major new bridges touted as models of Chinese engineering and construction excellence have collapsed into the river valleys below.



A Poisoned Environment

- ▶ Multiple major rain events have led to catastrophic flooding across the country – including Beijing.
- ▶ China's river dam systems are straining from record inflows leading to “managed” outflows which overrun downstream cities and farms.
- ▶ China's lax environmental regulations in the interest of production have poisoned China's streams and rivers and endangered citizen health.
- ▶ China is the world's leading polluter including the world's number one operator and builder of coal powered energy generation plants.
- ▶ Major Chinese cities suffer from dense smog from unmanaged air pollution.



A Demographic Timebomb

- ▶ China claims a population of 1.4 billion +, but abandoned villages, empty apartment buildings in major cities and endless ghost festivals suggest otherwise.
- ▶ It appears that China's population was either overstated by 150 to 250 million or the impact of Covid 19 was greater than the CCP admitted.
- ▶ Some sources are estimating that China's population may actually be approximately 800 million. The Chinese Police reports 770 million citizens with ID cards.
- ▶ China's current fertility replacement rate per woman is now .9, far under the 2.1 replacement standard despite its dissolution of the One Child policy.
- ▶ China's Ministry of Public Security reported 8.9 million births last year, 1.7 fewer than reported by the Bureau of National Statistics.
- ▶ Male children are still considered preferable which means that there are fewer women to give birth.



A Demographic Timebomb

- ▶ Fewer children while the population continues to gray, means fewer contributors to fund the Chinese social programs.
- ▶ Young Chinese men and women are choosing not to marry due to economic and social dissatisfaction. China reported only 6.1 million marriages in 2024.
- ▶ Private sector companies have adopted 35 as the target age for termination and replacement.
- ▶ A significantly large portion of Chinese women have passed the age of 27, making them “leftover” women, undesirable for marriage.
- ▶ We do not know the actual effect of the Covid 19 epidemic:
 - ▶ China has ceased reporting cremation data.
 - ▶ Citizens report continued mass infections and sudden deaths.
 - ▶ The scale of traditional Ghost Festivals is chilling and many jurisdictions have banned them as well as the sale of their materials.



A Citizen Revolt

- ▶ Chinese citizens through out the countryside have assaulted and killed local CCP government officials.
- ▶ Protestors march in city streets protesting failed government housing and policies which have robbed them of their savings and leave them destitute and on the streets.
- ▶ Chinese police and CCP troops have been called to quell protest and arrest participants.
- ▶ Internet access has been monitored and curtailed to deny citizen access to information incompatible with government decrees.
- ▶ Chinese citizens are protesting with their feet, escaping China for political and economic freedom.

What does the Future Hold for China?

- ▶ A bloody purge of CCP leadership.
- ▶ More intense crack downs on freedom to maintain CCP power.
- ▶ A new People's Revolution?
- ▶ Reckless military ventures promoting patriotism as a diversion from internal problems – for example, invading Taiwan or provocative confrontations with the US Navy and other Asian nations such as the Philippines. (This has been used by other totalitarian regimes such as Nazi Germany, the Soviet Union and Iraq.)
- ▶ Reckless military ventures and strong-arm tactics to capture raw materials similar to Japan's Near East policies prior to and into WW2.
