The Holocaust with Damian Adame
Wednesday, April 1st, 2026 1.00-3.00 PM in The Mesquite Room at The Oaks**

Damian Adame, a history teacher from Greensboro, NC, was selected along with 40 other educators to travel to Poland, where the Holocaust happened during World War II.

A 95-year-old Holocaust survivor had said, "The Holocaust was an experience that not too many survived, and he spoke about what the survivors had to do to survive". He realized that if they didn't start talking, everything that happened and everything they witnessed would eventually disappear with them."

In many ways, this Holocaust educational trip is to pick up where survivors left off, ensuring their stories continue to be told.

Damian said, "This trip is not just a tour of the camps and of these areas where the events occurred, but it is a walking classroom. He brings this education to the students at home in Greensboro, NC.

Damian will share the experience of this trip visiting death camps, ghettos, communities, and museums. He gains a deeper understanding, connection, and motivation to provide a clearer scope of what's going on with this horrific event in human history.

Damian wants to raise the importance of initiatives that support Holocaust education in schools, such as in his state of NC, which has passed legislation to combat historical distortion and Antisemitism.
