Treasurer Report

Thank you, Friends, for your support of our wonderful library. Hard to believe that three years ago we had to close our doors for the pandemic. Now we are open and thriving - with a new director, more programs and lots of books!

You, as a friend, are a big part of that. In 2020-21, we contributed **\$20,000** to support the operations of the library. In 2021-22, we transferred **\$24,880**. This was made possible because of all your contributions and the two Winter Evening events we hosted (Stephen King and Lois Lowry). For 2022-23, we were not able to host our winter evening. Even so, we raised **\$8,500** which was donated to the library this March.

We count on you, our members, to keep the Hobbs library open and able to offer the multitude of programs that so enhance what "library" means. Members of F-CHML put the smooth running of our library as the number one priority and that is where your kind donations go. Whether or not we meet that goal depends a great deal on your membership.
