

Hello,

Below are the details for the upcoming Auburn Runway extension project (dates and times are subject to change, NOTAMS will be updated accordingly):

## The Scope

A 200ft extension on the Runway 16 end and a 241ft extension on the Runway 34 end. Installation of new runway lighting and signs.

## **Runway Closures**

- Night Closures April 7 June 30 (Airfield Lighting Out of Service)
  - April 7-19
    - Dusk-dawn
    - April 20 May 21
      - Monday-Thursday 5pm-dawn
      - Friday-Sunday Dusk-dawn
- Day Closures
  - June 12 (times TBD)
  - **June 15-17** (times TBD)
  - o 5 day closure in July or August (times TBD)





## <u>Details</u>

- From April 20 May 21 Night work will be performed on the runway
- From April 6 May 13 day work will be performed on the 16 end of the runway. During this time the runway will be displaced 565 feet on the 16 end leaving available runway length at 2,835 feet. The Runway 16 numeral will be covered, and a temporary displaced threshold marking will be in place.
- Once work is completed on the north end it will shift to the runway 34 end. When this occurs, the runway 34 numeral will be covered, and a temporary displaced threshold marking will be in place. The runway will be displaced 655 feet on the 34 end leaving available runway length at **2,945 feet**.
- Schedule subject to change. Project updates and schedule changes will be reflected via NOTAMs and if time allows the airport's email notification list (<u>https://auburnmunicipalairport.com/</u> bottom of the page) and Facebook page (<u>https://www.facebook.com/auburnmunicipalairport/?ref=bookmarks</u>).
