ELIGIBILITY

Education Support enrolment criteria for students are:

- evidence that the Intellectual Disability, physical disability, or Autism diagnosis demonstrates eligibility for an individual disability allocation;
- the disability and any co-existing conditions result in a substantially reduced functional capacity to learn that is expected to be life-long; and
- a substantial or extensive level of adjustment is required to provide an appropriate education program

YEAR 6 TRANSITION

Our transition programme runs across Terms 2 to 4 and is designed to give year 6 students opportunities to engage in our school programs before commencing year 7.

The program consists of different activities to give our transition students a taste of what they will experience going forward.

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Submit an expression of interest with copies of medical, psychological and relevant educational reports.

ENROLMENT FORM

Upon acceptance, the following documentation will be required with your Child's enrolment form:

- Birth Certificate
- Australian Immunisation Register certificate / History statement within the last 3 months
- Court Order (if applicable)
- Proof of Address (current utility bill and land rates or rental agreement)

If your child was not born in Australia:

- Passport
- Visa Documentation including date of arrival
