Authority of Life Guards:

The lifeguards have the authority to enforce all rules and regulations and are empowered to impose on-the-spot penalties that may be necessary.

Rules and Regulations:

- 1. All users of the pool must conduct themselves in a courteous manner at all times which will ensure the safety of other swimmers. Absolutely no abusive language, boisterous conduct, loud or offensive music or breach of peace will be tolerated.
- 2. Each member has the responsibility to see that there is no littering or vandalism on pool property.
- 3. All members, including guests, shall use the pool at their risk. Pine Knolls assume no responsibility for any accident or injury or damage to any person or their property resulting from such use.
- 4. All swimmers, including guests, will v/ear swimsuits. No cut-off jeans or slacks will be allowed in the pool.
- 5. Such member shall pay for any property of the pool broken or damaged by a member or guest promptly. No person shall break any article belonging to the pool.
- 6. Pine Knolls Pool is for private members and their guests. Members must sign in upon arrival at the pool. A member must accompany guests and the guest fee must be paid to the guard on duty.
- 7. A lifeguard must be present at all times for swimmers to be allowed in the pool area.
- 8. Children ages 8-14 must pass a swimming test before coming to the pool alone. A parent must be present for this test and must sign the parental consent form.
- 9. Disrespect to the lifeguards will not be tolerated. Those who do so will be asked to sit out or be dismissed from the pool if problems persist.
- 10. No running or horse playing will be allowed in or around the pool.
- 11. Bathing suits are required at all times in the pool area. Young children who need diapers must wear swim diapers.
- 12. Eating, drinking, or chewing gum will not be allowed in the pool.
- 13. Diving is only permitted in the deep end only.
- 14. Water wings are allowed but an adult in the water must accompany children wearing them.
- 15. "Alcohol" is not allowed during normal pool hours.
- 16. Those using floating devices should never be in the deep end alone.
- 17. A first aid kit and emergency telephone are located in the lifeguard office.

- 18. Guest fees are \$5.00 per person per day
- 19. Residents of the Pine Knolls neighborhood may not be considered guests
- 20. No bikini "thong" bottoms.
- 21. All injuries, no matter how minor, should be reported to the lifeguard on duty.
- 22. Pets are not allowed inside the fenced pool area and buildings.
- 23. No glass in the pool area including the covered tables.
- 24. Responsible non-family members (baby-sitters) are allowed admittance when accompanied by a member.
- 25. Returned check fee: A \$25.00 processing fee will be imposed
- 26. A guardian, grandparent, immediate relative, or adult babysitter may bring your kids to the pool without a guest fee.

Guest Policies:

- 1. Members may bring guests, limited to 5 visits only.
- 2. Each swimming guest must pay a \$5.00 guest fee.
- 3. All guests are required to sign in prior to entry and must be accompanied by a member.
- 4. Members are responsible for the actions of any/ or any damages done by their guest.

Discipline Procedures:

- 1. Verbal warning of rule or infraction.
- 2. At the first offense, the offender shall be required to sit in the time-out area for a period of 5-10 minutes based on age.
- 3. If a second offense by the same child should occur, the lifeguard shall call the child's parents and report the offense to the pool authorities.
- 4. Should a third offense occur, the child shall be suspended from the pool for a period of seven days.
- 5. If four offenses by the same child have occurred, the lifeguard shall make a full report of the case to the pool authorities and the matter will be brought before Pine Knolls management.
- 6. Any member may be suspended or expelled for the misuse of the pool or facilities, or for the violation of the rules and regulations of the pool, for conduct unbecoming a lady or gentleman, or for not paying his/her dues.
