Professional Dress Code

Professional attire is the way you want others to see you in a creative and respected way. You want to keep your hair combed and styled at all times, clothing clean and in school standards, make up to be applied before you enter to building and descent and comfortable shoes.

Our dress code is BLACK, WHITE, and we allow Blue as a pop of color. You will be issued a school smock to be worn at **ALL TIMES** with attire unless you are wearing school logo. Accessories are always a way to add a touch of you to a basic uniform. School issued name tags must be worn at all times.

If you are out of dress code, you will be asked to clock out and change to the appropriate standard attire and you may clock back in when you have done so. If you do not have your school issued name tag on you will be asked to clock out until you have your name tag on. If you have lost your name tag you may purchase a new one.

Listed below are some suggestions to attire that is **ACCEPTED** and **NOT ACCEPTED** at Bailey's Institute of Beauty:

ACCEPTED:

- Professional attire
- Suits and jackets
- Baileys Institute of beauty endorsed logo wear.
- Skirts and shorts no longer than one inch above the knee.
- Slacks and capris
- Closed toe footwear
- Leggings are only to be worn with shirts that cover your bottom area.
- Shirts must have sleeves and must cover midriff

NOT ACCEPTED:

- Jogging suites
- Sweatpants.
- Hoodies and Sweatshirts
- Profanity logos, slogans and words on clothing
- Denim jeans
- Flip flops or Sandals
- Shorts
- Skirts or dresses that you are unable to bend over in
- Hats and Head scarfs (unless it is for religious reasons)
- Halter or tube tops
