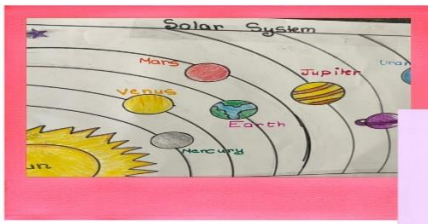
Science:-

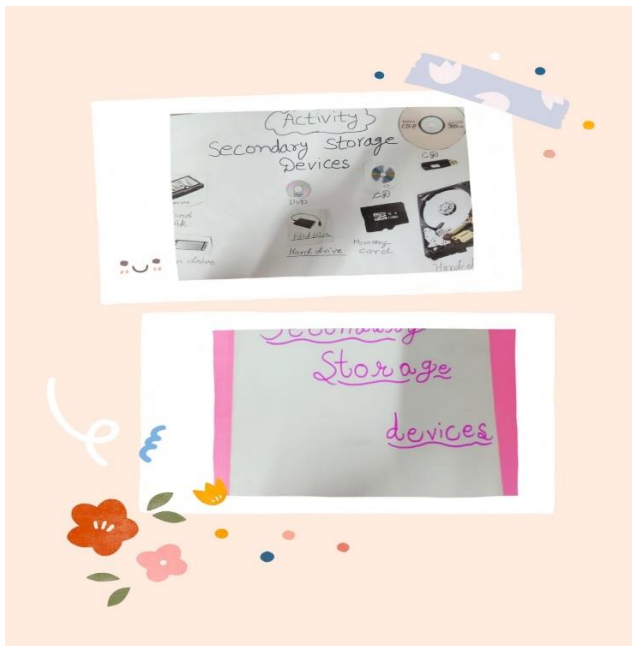
Social Science:-
