<u>Clubhouse Limitations – March 31, 2021</u>

The following references are currently in effect:

- 1. Governor's Executive Order 21-03-09-01, Signed March 9, 2021
 - Maryland remains in a state of emergency.
 - Mask mandate remains.
 - 6 feet of distancing remains.
 - Senior Centers remain closed.
- 2. Frederick County Board of Health Order 01-2021, Effective March 26, 2021 at 5:00 PM
 - Mask mandate remains.
 - 6 feet of distancing remains.

Based on the above state and local orders, the number of people allowed in the Clubhouse auditorium is limited by social distancing of 6 feet. Therefore, the maximum number of people allowed in the auditorium will be 60.*

*During Board and Community Meetings, the Board will be seated on the stage and will not count toward the total of 60 allowed on the floor of the auditorium.

Activities Remaining Closed:

- Bingo (until the mask mandate and/or state of emergency is rescinded).
- Potluck (until the mask mandate and/or state of emergency is rescinded).
- Card games (until social distancing is rescinded and/or reduced where games may be reasonably played).

Resumption of Other Activities:

- Activities may be resumed in the Clubhouse in compliance with 6 feet of social distancing and the wearing of masks at all times.
- Signups are required (for planning and for the potential for contact tracing).
- All activities are limited to residents only.
- Pandemic hours remain in effect.

<u>Temperatures will continue to be taken</u> when entering the Clubhouse, social distancing of 6 feet remains, and <u>masks shall be worn at all times while in the Clubhouse regardless of one's vaccination status</u>.

The safety of our residents remains the primary concern of the Board of Trustees. Since the pandemic began, there have been no cases of COVID-19 traced to the Clubhouse and the aim of the Board is to keep it that way. Adjustments will be made based on further directives from state and/or local authorities.
